DRESS CODE FOR DANCE CLASSES

Dress Code is a very important part of the dance training discipline. Similar to uniforms in organized sports, proper dancewear helps students develop the attitude and atmosphere for concentration and performance.

DANCE, MOMMY & ME (ages 2½ - 3½)

CREATIVE DANCE (ages 3½ - 4½)

Pants or shorts – any color, comfortable/flexible. T-shirt – any color.

PRE-BALLET (ages 4½ - 6)

BALLET-1 (ages 6 - 8)

BALLET-2 (ages 8 – 13)

Leotard – pink. Attached skirt or tutus - pink. Tights - pink. Ballet shoes - pink, beige or tan.

BALLET (teenagers and adults)

Leotard, Tights, Skirt – any color (black preferable). Ballet shoes – any color. Adults may wear practice clothes of their choice.

HIP HOP-1 (ages 4 – 11)

HIP HOP-2 (ages 12 – adults)

Pants or shorts – black, comfortable/flexible. Studio T-shirt, or black T-shirt.

PRE-TAP (ages 4½ - 6)

TAP-1 (ages 6 – 10)

TAP-2 (ages 11 – adults)

Leotard – any color. Tights – optional. Pants or shorts – any color, comfortable/flexible. Skirt – any color. Studio T-shirt. Tap shoes – black.

JAZZ (ages 7 & up)

Studio T-shirt. Tights – any color. Dance shorts – black. Jazz shoes – black.

BALLROOM

Dance shoes.

GROOMING FOR ALL CLASSES

- Hair must be pulled back off the face in either a bun or French braid. Short hair must be held back off the face with a wide hair band.
- No jewelry. Please be sure to leave valuables at home.
- No sweat shirts, oversized T-shirts, leg warmers, bra tops or midriff tops. Tights are to be worn under the Leotard.

NO STREET SHOES!

Please respect our dance floors. **Only dance shoes are permitted in our dance studios.** Street shoes track in sand and dirt onto our dance floor, leaving marks which are difficult to remove. Leave your street shoes on the shelf outside the dance rooms.
