

DRESS CODE FOR DANCE CLASSES

Dress Code is a very important part of the dance training discipline. Similar to uniforms in organized sports, proper dancewear helps students develop the attitude and atmosphere for concentration and performance.

BALLET, TAP

Ballet shoes - pink. Tap shoes- black. Leotard – pink or black. Skirt – pink or black. Tights – pink or tan.

HIP HOP

Dance pants or shorts - black. Studio T-shirt, or black T-shirt. Dance sneakers - black.

JAZZ

Studio T-shirt, or black T-shirt. Tights – tan. Dance pants or shorts – black. Jazz shoes – black.

FLOOR ACROBATICS

Leotard - black. Dance pants or shorts - black. No shoes.

GROOMING FOR ALL CLASSES

- Hair must be pulled back off the face in either a bun, neat ponytail or French braid. Short hair must be held back off the face with a wide hair band.
- No jewelry. Please be sure to leave valuables at home.
- No sweat shirts, oversized T-shirts, leg warmers, bra tops or midriff tops.

NO STREET SHOES!

Please respect our dance floors. **Only dance shoes are permitted in our dance studios.** Street shoes track in sand and dirt onto our dance floor, leaving marks which are difficult to remove. Leave your street shoes on the shelf outside the dance rooms.
